La Coordinatrice informa il CdS di avere ricevuto la Relazione finale CPDS 2023 . Dà dunque la parola al prof. Giorgianni, che riferisce in merito, ringraziando la dott.ssa Pizzo (invitata alla seduta) per la collaborazione. Il prof. Giorgianni comunica che la valutazione della CPDS sul CdS è molto positiva e in taluni casi eccellente. Permangono alcune criticità, che tuttavia come già negli anni passati derivano sostanzialmente dal mancato coordinamento tra laurea triennale di riferimento e magistrale e dalla condizione di filiera spezzata in cui opera il CdS. Il prof. Giorgianni sottolinea in particolare maniera il livello altissimo di valutazione espressa dagli



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studenti e l'altissimo gradimento espresso nei confronti della didattica, come quello relativo alla internazionalizzazione. Sottolinea le diverse buone prassi messe in atto dal CdS nella pubblicizzazione delle attività di internazionalizzazione, nell'organizzazione di Welcome Day e nella completezza del materiale didattico fornito agli studenti. Sottolinea ancora la soddisfazione dei laureati e la cura riservata dai docenti alla redazione delle schede di trasparenza. Precisa che permangono le criticità relative alle postazioni informatiche che sono comunque in lieve miglioramento. Segnala la necessità di sollecitare presso la segreteria studenti una maggiore solerzia nella registrazione dei cfu sostenuti all'estero, attualmente riportati in carriera con grave ritardo. La coordinatrice cede poi la parola alla Dott.ssa Pizzo che conferma il quadro delineato dal Prof. Giorgianni e sollecita inoltre l'allungamento degli orari delle biblioteche. Su questo punto interviene il prof. Casamento, delegato del Rettore al Sistema Bibliotecario di Ateneo, il quale spiega che è in corso di realizzazione un progetto che porterà all'apertura delle biblioteche di Viale delle Scienze, in alcuni casi fino alle 24.00, e in altri fino alle 19.00.

Programmazione tutorato studenti FC e studenti in corso

La Coordinatrice ricorda ai componenti del CdS che i dati della SMA 2022/23 evidenziavano, quali aree di miglioramento, gli indicatori iC13, iC16, iC16bis, quelli cioè relativi alla percentuale di CFU conseguiti al primo anno e nel passaggio dal primo al secondo anno. Benché questo valore si riferisca ancora al periodo pandemico e alle inevitabili conseguenze sulle carriere degli studenti e benché esso confligga prepotentemente con altri (in particolare iC02, iC17), è stato ipotizzato comunque che esso sia determinato anche dalle consistenti iscrizioni con riserva degli studenti, cui è preclusa la partecipazione agli esami della prima sessione invernale. Il CdS, già, lo scorso anno, come azione di miglioramento, aveva operato una riorganizzazione dell'OF per un migliore bilanciamento del carico didattico nel primo anno, con specifico riferimento ai Seminari obbligatori. Come ulteriori azioni di miglioramento, il CdS aveva disposto i seguenti provvedimenti:

- 1) incaricare l'AQ di esplorare, tramite il delegato alla didattica, possibili linee di intervento sul regolamento didattico di Ateneo, in merito alle iscrizioni con riserva e alla possibilità di recuperare una sessione d'esame.
- 2) organizzazione a partire dalla primavera prossima di un'azione di tutoraggio mirata, in particolare, sugli iscritti con riserva e fuori corso. Responsabile di tale azione sarà sempre l'AQ. Il monitoraggio dei risultati conseguiti sarà effettuato sulla base della SMA 2024-2025.

La prima azione attualmente non ha dato riscontri positivi, stando alle interlocuzioni avute con il delegato alla didattica e all'internazionalizzazione.

Si rende necessaria la messa in pratica di un'azione mirata di tutorato rivolta agli studenti iscritti con riserva e ai FC, anche ricorrendo ai tutor della didattica selezionati sulla base dell'apposito bando di Ateneo. La Commissione AQ si occuperà di individuare i destinatari del tutorato, non appena il numero degli iscritti sarà definitivo, e di mettere in pratica azioni personalizzate, riservandosi un primo monitoraggio di questa azione nel mese di luglio. Il CdS dopo ampia discussione all'unanimità approva.

La coordinatrice precisa di avere verificato presso il partner la volontà di proseguire la cooperazione come attestato nella lettera allegata al presente verbale. La Coordinatrice pertanto mostra al CdS il testo dell'accordo con le modifiche concordate con il partner che consistono nell'aggiornamento delle tabelle dei corsi e del personale accademico coinvolto nella gestione; nel riferimento alla Summer School organizzata nell'ambito dell'European Master in Classical Cultures; nella durata e nelle modalità di rinnovo dell'accordo. Dopo ampia discussione il CdS approva all'unanimità e seduta stante il testo definitivo dell'accordo qui di seguito riportato e anche in allegato al presente verbale.

DOUBLE MASTER DEGREE AGREEMENT

BETWEEN THE

UNIVERSITY OF PALERMO

AND THE UNIVERSIDAD DE SALAMANCA

concerning the



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Master Degree in “Scienze dell’Antichità” (Classe LM 15)”

awarded by the University of Palermo

and the

Máster Universitario en

“Textos de la Antigüedad Clásica y su Pervivencia”

(Máster Europeo de Culturas Clásicas)

awarded by the Universidad de Salamanca

On one part, University of Palermo, hereinafter also referred to as the “UNIPA”, with registered office at Piazza Marina n. 61, 90133 Palermo, Italy, and on its behalf and represented by prof. Fabrizio Micari, Rector of the University of Palermo;

on the other part the Universidad de Salamanca, with registered office at Patio de Escuelas 1, 37008 Salamanca, Spain, and on its behalf and represented represented by the Rector, Prof. Dr. Ricardo Rivero, hereinafter ‘The University’ and, jointly, ‘The Universities’

STATE



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1. that both institutions share cultural, technical, educational, and scientific fields of common interest;
2. that collaboration and the exchange of experience and knowledge, as well as the provision of services between both institutions, are in their greatest interest for social and cultural progress;
3. that they are interested in promoting their international collaboration in the field of higher education and research;
4. that they are both part of the Consortium "European Master in Classical Cultures". The European Master in Classical Cultures is an internationally integrated, interdisciplinary programme in Classical Studies, supported currently by 13 partner universities from 9 European countries.

THAT BEING SAID, THE PARTIES AGREE

to sign an agreement that regulates the conditions under which students may access and opt for a double Master Degree in "Scienze dell'Antichità (Classe LM 15)" and in Máster Universitario en "Textos de la Antigüedad Clásica y su Pervivencia (Máster Europeo de Culturas Clásicas)". The awarding of the double Master Degree, conferred by the two Universities in accordance with the current regulations at each institution, is subject to compliance with the clauses established in this agreement.

Art. 1: Purpose



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This agreement aims to establish the academic and administrative conditions under which students enrolled at the "Laurea Magistrale in Scienze dell'Antichità" at Palermo University, and students enrolled at the Máster Universitario en "Textos de la Antigüedad Clásica y su Pervivencia (Máster Europeo de Culturas Clásicas)" at Universidad de Salamanca, may access and opt for a double Master Degree conferred by both Universities, subject to compliance with the clauses established in this agreement, and in accordance with the current regulations at each institution in the current version of the time.

Both Universities consider that the two degree courses are similar and equivalent and mutually recognize the educational activities of the respective study programmes, which are listed in Annex 1 (a-b) and 2.

All procedural rules will be determined through the informal agreement between the Coordinators, on whom see 6.2.

Art. 2: General Regulatory Statutes

The University of Salamanca Master's Degree in "Textos de la Antigüedad Clásica y su Pervivencia" consists of 60 ECTS (15 ECTS from the work on the Master's Thesis), distributed over one academic year (two semesters). Eligibility for starting this programme is related to having successfully finished a 4-year BA-programme in Spain.

The Palermo Master's Degree in "Scienze dell'Antichità" consists of 120 ECTS (21 ECTS from the work on the Master's Thesis, distributed over two academic years (four semesters).

In order to make the Palermo Master's Degree programme compatible with the one in Salamanca, the following rules are to be applied:

1.- Students starting the Master's Degree programme in "Scienze dell'Antichità" at the Palermo University, and eligible to go to Salamanca later, will take the first and second semesters of their programme in their Home university (60 ECTS). In their third semester they will take 30 taught ECTS in Salamanca. In the fourth semester of their course they will acquire 30 ECTS, including the 21 ECTS of the master's thesis requested by Palermo University and valid also for the University of Salamanca.

When the thesis is defended, Palermo University acknowledges for it 21 ECTS, while the University of Salamanca 15 ECTS. This will give the student the 120 ECTS needed to obtain the degree from the Palermo University. To complete the 60 ECTS needed to obtain the degree from the University of Salamanca, the University of Salamanca will acknowledge the Palermo students 15 ECTS from the first and second semesters of the Master's programme at the Palermo University.



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Thesis will be defended by the students from Palermo University and Salamanca according to the timing provided for by their University.

2.- Students starting the Master's programme "Textos de la Antigüedad Clásica y su Pervivencia" at the University of Salamanca and accepted for the Palermo Master's Degree will take 30 taught ECTS in the first semester at Salamanca. In their second semester they will take at Salamanca 15 compulsory ECTS in the Classical Philology Module. During their first academic Master year at Salamanca, students shall not register for the Master's Thesis (TFM in Spanish), but rather in the following one, such that they shall continue to be official students of the University of Salamanca. In their third semester they will attend courses at the Palermo university and will take 30 ECTS. In their fourth semester they will work on a Master's Thesis of 21 ECTS in Salamanca. When the thesis is defended, Salamanca University acknowledges for it 15 ECTS, while the Palermo University 21 ECTS. This will give the student the 60 ECTS needed to obtain the degree from the Salamanca University. Thesis will be defended by the students from Palermo and Salamanca according to the timing provided for by their University.

To complete the 120 ECTS needed to obtain the degree from the Palermo University, the Palermo University will acknowledge to the students from the Salamanca University 21 ECTS from the fourth year of their Bachelor's Degree programme (Grado).

Art. 3: Pre-Selection Requirements

Students from Palermo University, who intend to opt for the double Master Degree in "Scienze dell'Antichità" / "Textos de la Antigüedad Clásica y su Pervivencia" must be regularly enrolled in the programme of "Filologia, letterature e storia dell'antichità", and have an adequate command of the Spanish language (at least at the B1 level), and an adequate knowledge of Latin and Ancient Greek.

Students from Universidad de Salamanca, who intend to opt for the double Master Degree in "Scienze dell'Antichità" / "Textos de la Antigüedad Clásica y su Pervivencia", must be regularly enrolled in the course of "Textos de la Antigüedad Clásica y su Pervivencia", have an adequate command of the Italian language (at least at the B1 level), and an adequate knowledge of Latin and Ancient Greek.

Art. 4: Selection



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The maximum number of students, which could be enrolled in the double Master Degree programme, is 2 (two) for each academic year by each University.

Each university will announce yearly the application call for participating to the double Master Degree programme.

Evaluation of the applications and applicants' selection will be mainly based on their motivation, academic career and the level of knowledge of English, and of Spanish and Italian as foreign languages, and of Latin and Greek, according to the local regulations of each university.

Students who possess a not yet adequate level of linguistic abilities can obtain, under previous approval of the Coordinators of the double Master Degree programme (see 6.2), a conditioned admission to the programme itself. In any case, the minimum linguistic level must be reached before starting the courses at the Host University.

The student's final admission requires approval by the Partner University and admission into its corresponding degree programme.

Art. 5: Enrolment. Students' rights and obligations

5.1 Enrolment

Students participating in the double Master Degree programme will enrol and will pay academic taxes at their Home University and not at the Host University. Anyway, students from Palermo moving to Salamanca will be charged with the opening file (apertura de expediente) and the diplom fees (expedición de título), due to the Junta de Castilla y León. The Host University will admit and enrol students issuing them the necessary documentation to ensure access to ordinary student services.

5.2 Students' rights and obligations

During the exchange period, the students will be subject to the rules and regulations of the Host University. Likewise, they will



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enjoy the same rights as students enrolled at the Host University.

If a student does not comply with the terms of this agreement, including the minimum length of the stay at the Host University and its study programme, that student will forfeit any right to receive the Master Degree from the Host University and will be excluded from the double Master Degree programme, although he/she may still be eligible to obtain the Master Degree at his/her Home University.

Art. 6: Organization and Didactics

6.1. Study programmes

The two Universities elaborate and approve, through their respective academic bodies, their own Master Degree courses' study programmes, duly articulated in modules and credits (CFU/ECTS): see Annexes 1 (a-b) and 2. The study programmes must regard the entire period right through to the achievement of the diploma. Didactics is organized in semesters.

The Universities can modify their own curricula. Each University communicates promptly to the Partner prospective changes in its own curriculum.

The study programmes may provide specific lessons, considering the bi-national character of the education, summer schools and 'stages' (Praktika) at enterprises and/or public entities, also in third countries.

The study programmes provide also week-long interdisciplinary compact course (blockseminar), which is organized by the local coordinators and take place every two years at changing locations of the EMCC Universities. It provides students with the opportunity to present and discuss the main points of their ongoing Masters thesis internationally. Presentations are worth 5-6 credits, depending on the regulations of the home university.

6.2. Local Coordinators

Each Partner University appoints a Local Coordinator for the exchange programme.

The Local Coordinator:

- attends to the didactic and administrative coordination with the Partner University;



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- follows, from a didactic point of view, students from his/her own University, who participate in the exchange programme, advising them on their plan of studies and remaining in contact with them for the entire duration of the programme;
- welcomes the students of the Partner University participating in the exchange, as soon as they arrive at his/her University;
- follows the students of the Partner University from a didactic point of view, advising them on their plan of studies and checking periodically the progress of their study programme during their stay at his/her Institution;
- guarantees correct administrative management of the exchange programme and is responsible for its quality control (see 6.4).

6.3. Student's learning activities and their recognition

Each student admitted to the double Master Degree programme must define her/his plan of study with the assistance of the local Coordinators in accordance with the study programmes of the Home and Host University. The responsible academic bodies – supported by the local coordinators – will establish, case-by-case, correspondences between the learning activities carried out by the student in the Partner University and the educational offer of their own University (see Annex 2).

When organizing the stay, the academic calendar of each University will be considered. The students participating in the double Master Degree programme must attend one semester at the Partner University and they must achieve there a minimum of 30 (thirty) credits (CFU/ECTS) and a maximum of 60 (sixty) credits (CFU/ECTS).

All students admitted to the double Master Degree programme must register at the Host University and present at their arrival the transcript of records of the courses already taken at their Home University.

The Host Universities undertake to award students of the Partner University a transcript of records of the courses taken during their stay. The certificate must be issued in English.

After completing the stay, the students must submit to their Home University the official transcript of records issued by the Host University in order to receive credit for the courses taken.

6.4 Quality control



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Both Local Coordinators of the double Master Degree programme will meet, also by video conference, at least once in a year, to evaluate the effectiveness of the learning programme and the results achieved by students, as well as the resources supplied by both Universities. To improve the quality of the programme, the Coordinators could suggest modifications and propose them to the competent boards of both Universities. Substantial changes to structure, organisation, and in evaluation mechanisms of the programme could be implemented through amendments to this text.

Art. 7: Funding, Expenses, Insurance

7.1. Teaching staff

The two Universities can cover the travel and living expenses of their professors sent abroad to the Partner University within the double Master Degree programme, depending on available financial resources. These business trips can also take place within the framework of other mobility programmes.

7.2 Students

Transport costs, medical insurance, accommodations, upkeep, and any other expenses the student will incur during the exchange period established in the double Master Degree programme will be charged to the student. The partner university pledges to provide assistance in the search for suitable accommodations through its administrative offices. The students involved can apply for scholarships or other financial aid instruments to cover the mobility costs. Each University may assign grants to its own students partaking in the joint study programme on the basis of appropriate selection call for candidates.

Medical assistance as well as health and accident insurance will be dealt with in accordance to the legislations of the hosting countries. Health insurance is not provided by the Universities. If medical assistance or health and accident insurance are not regulated by international agreements among the countries involved, each student participating in the programme under this agreement shall be required by his/her University to purchase sufficient health and accident insurance for the duration of his/her participation.

The two Universities inform furthermore the students about their responsibility for damages that they could involuntarily cause to third parties (persons/objects) during their study period abroad, within the ambit of the activities relevant to this agreement. Students are therefore advised to take into consideration the possibility of stipulating an insurance, which protects them with



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regard to the above risks and responsibilities.

Art. 8: Administration/Technical Reference Offices

The non-teaching reference offices for the exchange at the Palermo University are listed in the Annex 3a.

The non-teaching reference offices at Universidad de Salamanca are listed in the Annex 3b.

Art. 9: Teaching Staff Reference Persons

The teaching staff reference persons (= Coordinators) for the exchange at the Palermo University are listed in the Annex 4a.

The teaching staff reference persons (= Coordinators) for the exchange at Universidad de Salamanca are listed in the Annex 4b.

Art. 10: Teaching Methodology and Evaluation

During the study period, students participating to the double Master Degree programme will take part in the teaching activities of the Host University as they are regularly carried out. Courses are taught in the language of the host country.



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The participating students will be evaluated according to the same criteria and with the same methodology regularly used at the Host University.

Art. 11: Final Degree Exam

At the end of their bi-national study programme, students will prepare a Master's thesis under the supervision of a professor of each University. The final degree exam will be held at the Home University and the elaborate will be completed by a summary (between a minimum of 5 [five] and a maximum of 10 [ten] pages) written in the language of the Host University. The supervisor from the Host University will be invited to be part, also by video conference, of the committee of the final examination, which will be hence accordingly integrated or enlarged. The resulting costs will not be borne by the Home University. The Partner University can cover them, as provided for in art. 7.1. If the supervisor from the Host University should not be able to personally intervene, he/she will intervene – in accordance with the relevant examination regulations – by video conference call service provider or he/she will send a report with his/her evaluation, which will be taken into account by the committee of the final examination in the Home University, to the extent that it is legally permissible.

Art. 12: Requirements for Awarding the Degree

After the final exam in his/her Home University, provided that the student has fulfilled his/her duties at the Host University as well, the Host University will award the degree upon submission by the student of degree application upon sending of a transcript from his/her Home University recording the final exam.

Art. 13: Settlement of Controversies

Controversies concerning the interpretation and fulfilment of the agreed terms and conditions will be settled by mutual assent. If necessary, the settlement of controversies shall be entrusted to an Arbitration Court composed by 3 (three) members, one appointed respectively by each party, and the third chosen by mutual consent.



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Art 14: Duration and Termination

This agreement will take effect from the time of its signing by the representatives of both Universities, and will be valid for a period of 4 (four) years and can be renewed one single time for a second period of 4 (four) years; the agreement will be automatically renewed for this second term unless otherwise stated by either of the signatory institutions. Following this eight year period, the agreement may be renewed by written consent. Either one of the signatory institutions may terminate this agreement in writing, which must be sent to the partner institution 6 (six) months in advance. If one institution wishes to terminate this agreement, both pledge to meet their commitments to the students admitted into the double Master Degree programme before either one withdraws from it.

Moreover, the signature of this agreement does not mean any financial fulfilment to the parties.

Art. 15: Academic and research exchanges

With the aim of supporting the double Master Degree programme, the Palermo University and Universidad de Salamanca will promote and coordinate by mutual consent the exchange of visiting professors and researchers as well as the organisation of workshop, seminars, conferences and publications on topics of common interest. The exchange and the development of the activities above mentioned will conform to the norms and procedures in force in the two institutions.

Art. 16: Use of Logo

The Partners mutually commit not to use the name and/or logo or any other identifying marks of the other University for purposes other than those covered by the agreement, or for communication initiatives on this double degree programme. The



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right to use the name and/or logo or any other identifying marks of the other University as described in sentence 1 is limited to the duration of the Agreement.

Art. 17: Personal data treatment

Universities will arrange for the treatment, the dissemination and communication of personal data in pursuit of their institutional goals and as provided by law.

Art. 18: Final Clauses

This agreement is drawn up in 2 (two) copies in English, each of these texts being equally authentic. All misinterpretations will be settled by mutual assent. Annexes 1 (a-b) and 2 can be modified by informal agreement between the parties. Each institution communicates to the Partner any change that should affect Annexes 3 (a-b) and 4 (a-b).
