"Exploring the Circular Economy in Burgundy"

Organising university: University of Burgundy

Organisers: Florence MARTY and Alice MERIAUDEAU – IUT Le Creusot (Le Creusot Campus) The IUT Le Creusot is part of the University of Burgundy. Le Creusot city, located about 90 km from Dijon, has about 22,000 inhabitants and 1,500 students on the Le Creusot campus. The IUT includes 4 departments: 3 departments from the industrial sector and one department from the tertiary sector.

Type of mobility: Erasmus+ Blended Intensive programme (BIP)

Dates physical mobility: 07.04.2025 - 11.04.2025

Dates virtual mobility: Three sessions following the physical mobility

Type of scholarship: Erasmus+ blended short-term mobility funding.

Students participate in a BIP as part of a short-term blended mobility. Funding rates for short-term blended mobility for students are communicated by each FORTHEM partner university.

Project description: Exploring the Circular Economy in Burgundy

This blended mobility aims to raise students' awareness of the circular economy. Through virtual presentations and during the face-to-face conferences, discussions, and visits to local companies, our objective is to encourage students to question their practices considering environmental and societal issues. An introductory module will allow students to understand the issues related to this new economic model. This reflection will invite them to rethink our methods of production, consumption and waste management.

This program also has a cultural aim by promoting exchanges between students from different cultures and by offering the opportunity to share the French local culture and French language by staying with a host family* or at the hotel if there is no more place available in the host family.


