HOSPITAL INTERNSHIPS

Before arriving in Palermo, incoming students (both for Erasmus for study and for traineeship or other Internalization programs) who will be undertaking hospital internships must have completed all the necessary clinical exams to access the hospital wards.

If the incoming student has not included a discipline that requires internship activities in the learning agreement but intends to undertake one, the student must inform the destination coordinator in a timely manner (by July).

The destination coordinator will collect all internship requests from students and send a list with names, interested wards, and ECTS to: Anna Aiello/Giuseppe D’Anna/Antonella Occhipinti, who will be responsible for organizing the students' placements in the various indicated wards.

The hospital internship activities for incoming Erasmus students will take place in Palermo, the only site authorized to receive them.

Students must adhere to the assigned hours and days for the internship activities. It will be the students' responsibility to get their attendance certified in the wards to which they have been assigned.

The destination coordinator, after confirming the above attendance, will prepare the internship attendance certificate, sign it, and send it to the student and the partner university.

LECTURES

Incoming students who need to attend lectures at our University must promptly register, upon arrival in Palermo, at the student office, which will assign them a registration number.

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Incoming students can choose to follow a module of an integrated course rather than the entire integrated course. In this case, the destination coordinator must include the single module with its code in the learning agreement, not the entire integrated course.

Lectures will all be conducted in Italian, and separate classes will not be established for incoming students. Exams will also be conducted in Italian (unless the individual lecturer agrees to conduct the exam in English, but this is not mandatory).

Since Erasmus students can choose to include subjects from different academic years in their learning agreement, they will have the opportunity to attend lectures planned for students in both the Nightingale and Gordon channels (both channels based in Palermo) if there are scheduling conflicts. The destination coordinator must ensure that students are enrolled in both channels to verify their presence in the classroom. If it is impossible to attend all the indicated subjects, the student will have to drop some subjects from the learning agreement since all lectures have mandatory attendance. Like all other students, the incoming Erasmus student must record their attendance at lectures through the OTP (one-time password).

According to the terms set by the call for applications, it will be possible to modify the learning agreement (“during the mobility”).

Moreover, it will be the responsibility of the destination coordinator to coordinate with the manager to open the exam sessions specifically for incoming students.

At the end of the training period, the destination coordinator will send the partner university the student’s final TOR (“Learning agreement after mobility”) and any certificate of attendance for laboratory activities.
