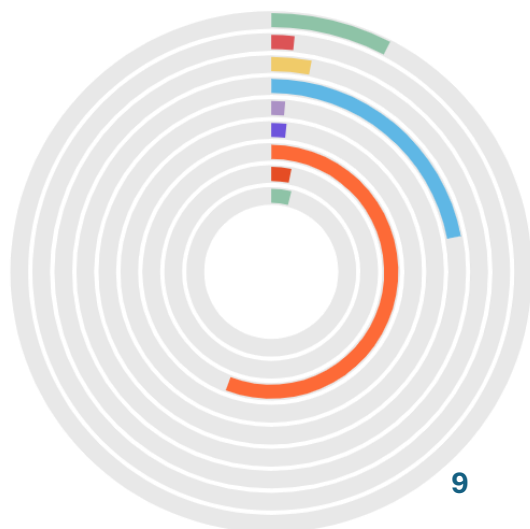

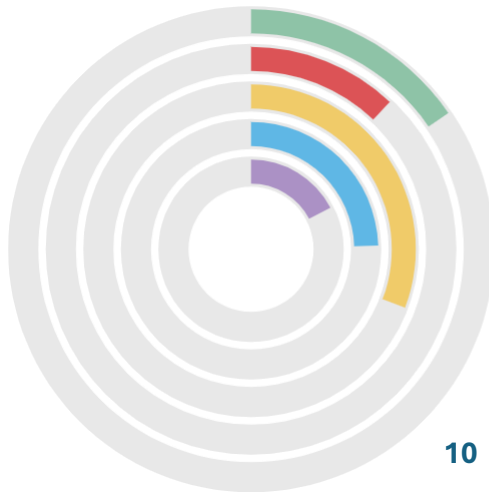

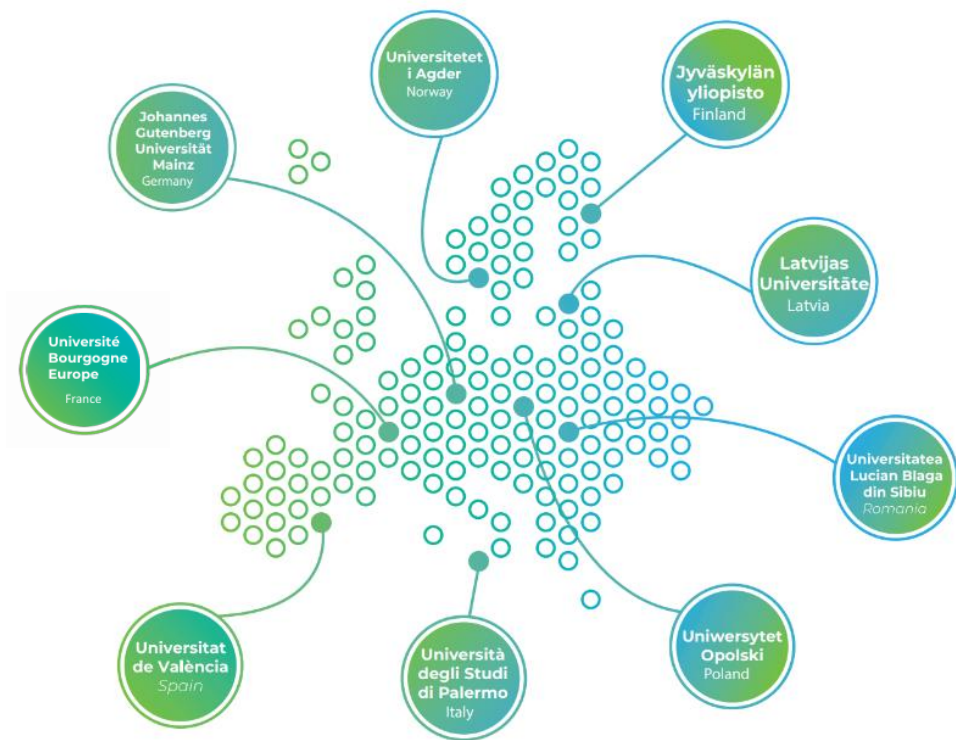

Nursing

Nursing graduates are health professionals, who carry out activities for the prevention, treatment, and protection of individual and collective health. Alongside the frontal teaching activity, there is a parallel guided internship path, in which the student learns and applies interventions aimed at planning the work in the nursing field.

Only to mention, practical clinical training can be carried out at the IRCCS-ISMETT under the supervision of dedicated English-speaking tutors.

Business & Economic Sciences

Curriculum: Entrepreneurship and Management

The Master provides students with a solid knowledge of business, management, economics, mathematics, and statistics. The course enables students to work in the different areas of business of private and public companies. By learning how to develop and apply qualitative and quantitative knowledge, graduates acquire the qualifications for future challenges in business and management.

Complex Administrations and Organizations Science

Curriculum: Sustainability in Management and Governance

The Master aims to teach how to support coordination in policy design, implementation and performance management, between the different components of the public sector. The Master program provides the possibility to obtain a double degree with the Corvinus University of Budapest (Hungary) or with the University of Hanoi (Vietnam).

Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence

The Master provides theoretical, experimental, and practical skills on data representation and computation, for efficient and intelligent information processing. The program covers transversal topics in Data, Algorithms, and Machine Intelligence, as well as in-depth studies in application areas where data are big, relations are complex, and machine-learning structures are deep.

Economic and Financial Sciences

Curriculum: Economic and Financial Analysis

The Master Degree program in Economic and Financial Analysis provides a solid background into advanced knowledge of macro and microeconomics, the functioning of financial markets and the banking sector. In addition, the course delves into quantitative methods aiming to train economists working for the private, public sector and for international organizations, as well as consultants for the financial services sector.

Tourism systems and hospitality management

The Master, stemming from an agreement between the University of Palermo and the Chaplin School of Tourism and Hospitality Management at Florida International University (FIU), helps graduates prepare for the next step in their career in the global tourism and hospitality industry. Skills for managerial-level positions and high level of internationalization are two of the main distinctive features of the course.

Curriculum: International Studies

Curriculum: International Trade

In a stimulating multicultural environment, the Master, with its two curricula in International Trade and International Studies, offers students the opportunity to study from a multidisciplinary perspective the complexities of the international context and the fundamental dynamics of doing business globally. The Master program provides also an international mobility agreement with the Foreign Trade University in Hanoi (Vietnam).

Spatial Planning

The Master trains experts in urban design and sustainable territorial development. The skills gained through this Master Degree are those required in designing and managing territorial resources, building stock (both historic and contemporary) and complex systems such as landscapes and environments.

Mediterranean Food Science and Technology

The Master provides detailed knowledge on food processes of the Mediterranean area. Food chemistry, technology and microbiology are mainly represented. Several laboratory sessions on sensory analysis of foods and meeting with national food-beverage companies are provided during lessons.

Environmental Science and Technologies

The Master prepares graduates in Natural, Geological, or Biological Sciences to tackle environmental challenges with multidisciplinary expertise. It equips students to be biologists, ecologists, and research technicians. It also empowers them for careers in environmental analysis, pollution management, waste handling, bioremediation, certification, impact assessments, and planning.

Cooperation, Development, and Migrations (COSVIM)

The COSVIM trains experts specialized in international cooperation and governance of migration fluxes. It provides a broad range of employment opportunities in areas that currently lack adequately skilled professionals.



Neuroscience

This Master trains students as experts in Neuroscience and Neurobiology and as managers in research divisions aimed at creating new drugs, new bio-engineering technologies for the management, diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the central and peripheral nervous system.

Electronics Engineering

The Master provides the answer to the need for transversal applications, including photonics, nanoelectronics, smart cities, Internet of Things, automotive, tele-medicine and e-health. Four curricula are offered: *Modern Electronics*; *Telecommunications*; *Bioelectronics*; *Robotics and Mechatronics*.

Statistics and Data Science

The Master trains experts in data management, analysis, and statistical modeling for sectors like healthcare, finance, economics, and business. Students gain skills in Big Data, AI, cloud computing, and advanced statistical software. Graduates are highly sought after for roles in research, public and private organizations, and official statistics, working in data analysis, forecasting, and decision-making across various industries in Italy and abroad.

Automation and Systems Engineering

The Master trains professionals to design, control, and manage complex systems in industrial and information engineering, focusing on smart automation, robotics, and Industry 4.0. The multidisciplinary program integrates automatic control, industrial engineering, and ICT, covering cybersecurity, AI, IoT, and manufacturing technologies. Hands-on laboratory activities, internships, and seminars enhance expertise, preparing graduates for roles in intelligent, interconnected industries.

Management Engineering

The Master focuses on the managerial education of engineers. This is the reason why the educational objective of the course is to provide advanced and scientific knowledge of managerial issues: project management, innovation management, marketing, corporate finance, strategy, supply chain management. Four curricula are offered: *Data Analytics For Business, Digital Transformation, Innovation And Entrepreneurship, Sustainability And Social Impact*

Migrations, Rights, Integration

The Master offers specialized training on contemporary human mobility and migrant integration, with a focus on Europe and Italy. It prepares experts with advanced knowledge of migration law, fundamental rights and inclusion, situating these within broader social, historical and economic contexts. Students will explore the causes and impacts of migration, border regulation, migrant rights and integration policies through a multi-level legal framework. The program equips them to navigate international, European and national regulations, critically assessing policies, norms and institutions.



Transnational German Studies

The Joint Degree was developed by the four universities of Porto, Luxemburg, Mainz and Palermo. The Master's degree program, to great extent taught in German, offers advanced training in linguistic, historical and literary fields, complemented by work experience through internships and laboratories in the partner countries.

The program offers students an attractive master's degree in cultural studies and the humanities which:

1. Explores European culture and ideas in depth through an advanced approach;
2. Offers a wide range of interdisciplinary and trans-European content;
3. Provides an international degree with structured experiences at European universities;
4. Integrates essential extra-disciplinary skills, including intercultural, linguistic, and career-relevant competencies.



Management Engineering

The course aims to train professionals with skills in the design and production of electronic systems and measurement systems and in the definition of telecommunications architectures, systems and services.

International Relations, Politics and Trade

The course aims to train experienced professionals in the internationalization processes of companies. The expert in internationalization processes is responsible for fine-tuning and developing the company's strategy and activities on international markets, whether of a commercial nature (import/export management, e-commerce), production or distribution, regardless of the production sector, expressed also through the stable presence in the target countries.

Electronics and Telecommunications Engineering

The course aims to train professionals with skills in the design and production of electronic systems and measurement systems and in the definition of telecommunications architectures, systems and services.

Online Course Offering



Courses are mainly or exclusively offered online through the dedicated e-learn University platform based on Moodle, accessible anytime anywhere!

Courses are available through the e-learning platform Moodle. It is accessible anytime, anywhere!

Training services are available 24/7, with activities offered in both asynchronous and synchronous modes (many-to-many), and in scheduled times and methods for live events (one to many).

Activities take place within four learning environments:

The Video Library: it includes video lessons and related presentations.

The Media Library: it includes materials in support of the video lessons (e.g., handouts, diagrams, animations, bibliographic references).

The Virtual Laboratory: it is the "learning by doing" tool.

The Online Tutoring environment: it is used to carry out remote tutoring activities.

Research and Third Mission

Research and Third Mission – New University Centers

Centre of Advanced Studies (A.S.CENT.) aims to enhance the University's research by promoting collaboration, innovation, and the dissemination of science and technology. It fosters international knowledge exchange and interdisciplinary dialogue, creating a dynamic space for ideas, projects, and research. Internationalization, interdisciplinarity, and knowledge sharing drive its academic and scientific initiatives.



Centre for Sustainability and Ecological Transition is a multidimensional initiative that spans research, education, collaboration with stakeholders, and internal sustainability efforts.

Aten Center is a research and development (R&D) hub specializing in biotechnology for human health. It boasts state-of-the-art laboratories and equipment, a strong focus on interdisciplinary collaboration and a commitment to technology transfer and market-oriented research. Its broad range of activities makes it a valuable resource for both scientific research and industrial development in the Mediterranean area.

Scholarships

ERSU Scholarship

Administered by the Regional Agency for the Right to Education (ERSU), these scholarships are awarded based on income and merit. Benefits include:

- Financial support;
- Accommodation in university residences;
- Access to subsidized dining services



Other Scholarship

UNIPA also provides scholarships often in collaboration with regional, national, and global organizations. These opportunities include:

- Tuition fee waivers: Full or partial exemptions from tuition fees.
- Living grants: Financial support for living expenses during studies.

The most benefits and scholarships are awarded through a competitive application process.

Scholarships at UniPa

Just Peace Scholarship

The University of Palermo issues a notice of 20 scholarships for students from Palestine, Ukraine, and other war-torn countries enrolled in on-campus Bachelor/Master's degree programs.

MAECI Scholarship

Grants for foreign and Italian citizens living abroad awarded by the Italian Government (for non-EU students requiring a visa)



CRUI Scholarship

100 scholarships from the Ministry of the Interior- CRUI for refugee students



Accommodation

Unipa Housing Service

Free service to help non-resident and international students find suitable accommodation provided by private individuals. Housing options are pre-visited by UNIPA housing service staff and then listed in an accessible database



ERSU

The Regional Authority for the Right to University Study of Palermo (ERSU) offers a housing service allocated based on a ranking system following a call for applications. This service is designed to support and assist university students throughout their academic journey. ERSU offers all participants in the “non-resident” call the opportunity to request a bed in one of the university residences managed by ERSU Palermo.



Language Centre (Centro Linguistico di Ateneo, CLA)

CLA provides foreign language classes to undergraduates, outgoing Erasmus participants, and to enrolled students, as well as professors and the academic staff. The Centre offers innovative services in the field of languages, such as the Open Badge (digital verification of language proficiency), Rosetta Stone (online language courses) and online Test of Language Proficiency (TALs). For those interested in learning Italian, Unipa-ItaStra offers Italian language courses for migrants, Erasmus students (incoming) and foreign students enrolled at the University of Palermo. The Centre organizes Summer and Winter Schools with intensive Italian Language and Italian culture courses.



Library Services and Historical Archive (SBA)

SBA includes libraries, an historical archive and coordinating offices. It supports the University's mission and it ensures teaching support through the maintenance and continuous updating of bibliographic collections, now available in diverse and hybrid formats.

The Library System also strongly supports academic research and enhances the impact of the University's researchers. It organizes exhibitions, events, and joins local, national and international projects, with the aim of promoting the University libraries and their valuable collections. The UniPa Library System portal serves as a hub through which users can explore the University's libraries, collections, bibliographic research tools, services offered (available on-site and online) and access procedures.

SIMUA fosters the valorisation of UNIPA cultural heritage. It helps preserve a varied heritage of archaeological, historical, artistic, and scientific value made of historical buildings, chapels, paintings, museums, and botanical garden. Such sites are regularly open to the public or can be visited upon request.



Canteen

With a commitment to quality and variety, the canteen offers meals from local Italian favourites to international cuisines, , catering to all dietary preferences and intolerances.

The menus vary daily and each canteen posts the dishes of the day and alternative proposals at the entrance.

Timetables are posted at the entrance to each dining hall; generally, lunch is served from 12.00 to 15.00, while dinner is served from 19.00 to 21.30.

In addition, the dining hall of the S. Romano University Residence, the main canteen on the University Campus, offers a pizzeria service open every day from 19:30 to 22:30.
