
Holistic Analysis of Italian and US Healthcare Systems

June 3rd-4th, 2024









Summer School Description

Healthcare systems are having to respond to the number of competing challenges. The pressures of globalization, aging populations, increasing patient demands, and the rising costs of research and medical treatments are forcing us to look more critically at how healthcare is delivered to devise changes for the future. Changes made to health systems are often based on economic and political rationale and many countries currently experiencing significant changes to the way in which healthcare systems have historically been funded and delivered.

This course will introduce students to the healthcare system in Italy and the context within which it operates. It will start by looking at the introduction of the National Health System (NHS) in 1978 and take students through the key changes that have taken place right up to the present day.

Students will be able to compare both the Italian and the American healthcare systems.

Students will explore a range of key concepts and themes in comparative healthcare from a multidisciplinary perspective, including biodiversity, nutrition, chronic disease management, social structure, and marginalization.

Throughout this course, special attention will be paid to comparisons between Italy and the USA, to allow students to directly relate their learning to their own educational and healthcare setting and contrasting health systems. Emphasis will be placed on the multiple factors that determine health at the individual and population levels. By comparing patterns of health across different demographic groups, immigration status and so on, students will explore a range of different intersections to expand their understanding of impacts of healthcare challenges.
