Description



The Master Course (LM) in "Migration, Rights, Integration" provides training on global human mobility in various dimensions. The different teachings frame the migration phenomenon in a complex historical and geopolitical setting, providing a critical knowledge on norms and policies about asylum, migration, and social inclusion on European and international scales.

A solid practical vocation complements the theoretical preparation through internships, workshops, and participatory teaching.

Graduates will be able to hold positions of responsibility in the public and private sectors and NGOs, especially in international agencies and projects to support the rights of people on the move and fruitful interaction with host societies.

The MIDI Master's program is based on the premises of the Law Department of the University of Palermo.

It is located in ancient buildings in the historic center, close to the city's most important monuments. Its classrooms are equipped for multimedia and innovative teaching.

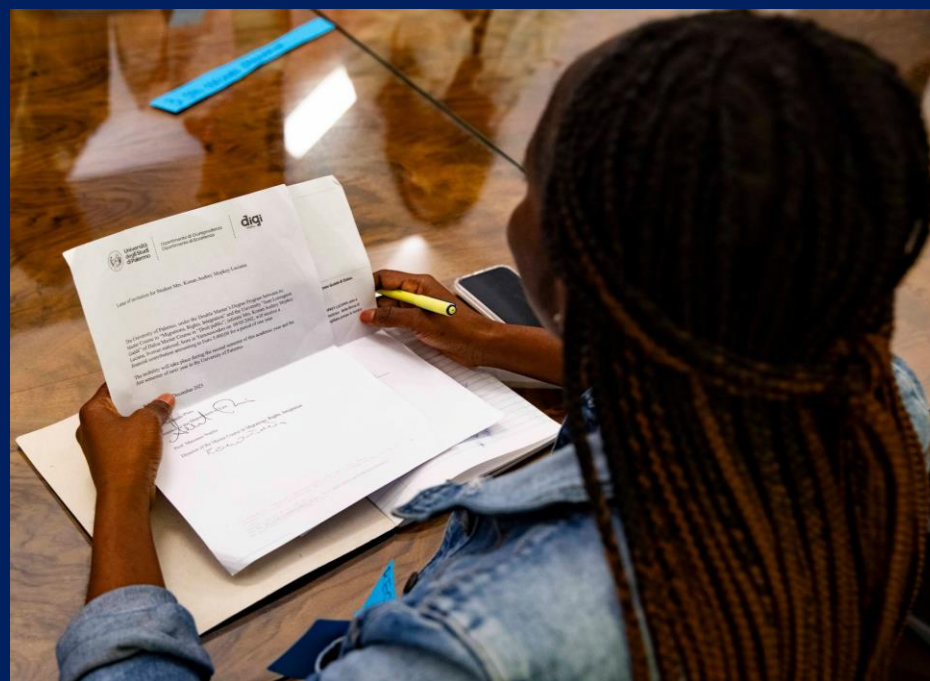

Check paid internships with European and international entities. Day with member of the European commission who will explain these possibilities

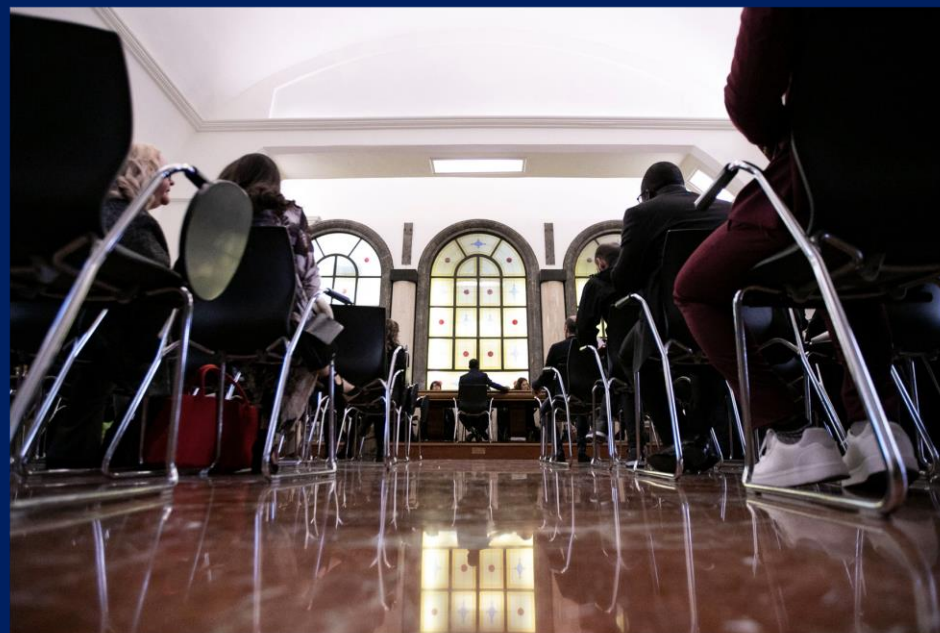


Graduation
